Buy local and authentic products

In addition to helping the local economy, it values and encourages the population to preserve customs and identity.

Whenever possible, travel on foot or by bicycle.

For longer distances, opt for public or alternative transport as they reduce your carbon footprint.

Respect Nature.

Don't leave the trails marked in the natural parks, throw your garbage in the appropriate places and if there are none, take it with you.

Say no to plastic.

Choose to take a reusable water bottle with you and do not use plastic bags

Travel less, bundle more

plan to combine trips reducing environmental impact

Take less luggage

the heavier the transport, the more emissions it produces

Try Glamping

Take a shower, not a bath.

Invest in eco-friendly products

Not everything is instagrammable.

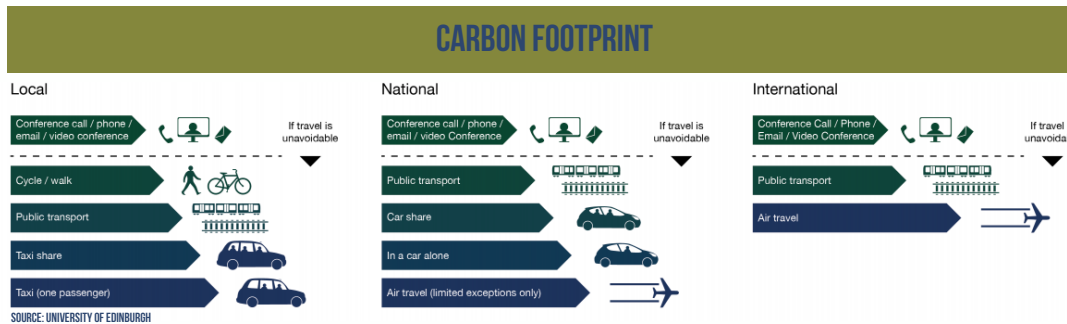
Respect the locals and their customs. Don't take pictures of anyone without asking for permission
